YEAR I JOINED: 2018



# Little Souls in a Snapshot



We are a small not-for-profit centre located on the Gold Coast licenced for up to 28 children and we primarily operate as a fee for service. All profits from the centre and all donations from the community is directed back into Little Souls ASD Therapy Programs and Resources. All donations are tax deductible. Little Souls is a unique centre in Australia providing vital intensive early intervention therapy that includes social inclusion with typically developing children.



Our defining element is that we invest heavily in our staff resources so that we can achieve our mission. Our culture of inclusiveness and highly structured programs assist children with Autism reach their full potential.

On average Little Souls caters on a daily basis for up to 14 children with Autism and 14 typically developing children. Each child with autism is unique, and their challenges are distinctive, but we have seen many participants achieve gains of up to two years in just 12 months. It's because of our dedicated staff that we can achieve this.
